

#### **DIVINE MERCY**



In Between 1931-1938, Jesus transmitted His message of Divine Mercy to a young uneducated nun in Poland, the now St. Faustina. The most important aspect of His message was that a Feast of Divine Mercy be established on the first Sunday after Easter. Pope St. John Paul II on April 29, 2000 canonized St. Maria Faustina Kowalska as the first saint of the new millennium and proclaimed this day as a

universal feast for the Church.

Our Lord revealed to St. Faustina "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners" (Diary 699).

Next Sunday, April 7th, we will celebrate from 3-4pm (the hour of Mercy) with Eucharistic Adoration, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, prayers and veneration of the Mercy of God.
